While the Online Sanctioning process has existed for the past few months, we have also continued to accept paper applications. We will move completely over to the online process beginning September 1, 2013.

What does this mean for you?

2. Ease of use and more capabilities - process your sanction anytime, from anywhere!
3. Ability to order certificates of insurance online.
4. Quicker and less impactful to the environment (no paper and no mailing/faxing).

In order to meet our September 1 goal, a few key projects are occurring:
